Renter Facts for Legislative District 47

This fact sheet contains information collated from the U.S. Census Bureau's American Community Survey 2022 data.¹ This is the most recent ACS data available.

Key Facts:

- Renters are approximately 32% or 48,400 of the 153,597 people housed in LD 47.
- Approximately 52% of renter households in LD 47 pay more than 30% of their income in rent. HUD defines these households as cost burdened. That's approximately 8,365 renter households.
- Median monthly rent in LD 47 is \$1,747 or \$20,964 annually.
 - The first 7% annual increase in rent will be \$122.
 - The second annual 7% increase will be \$131.
 - The third annual 7% increase will be \$140.
 - Rent will have increased \$393 amount over just 3 years to a total of \$2,140 a month.
